AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES OF THE HARVARD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT FOR 16214 ST. PATRICK ROAD, WOODSTOCK, ILLINOIS, PIN 07-15-200-003

WHEREAS, the property commonly known as 16214 St. Patrick Road, Woodstock, Illinois, consisting of approximately 80 acres with PIN 07-15-200-003 (the "Subject Property") is located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Harvard Fire Protection District and on the border of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District;

WHEREAS, the owner of the Subject Property also has vacant property contiguous to the Subject Property, located southeast of the intersection of St. Patrick Road and Wilson Road, with PIN 07-14-100-003 and located within the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District. Said properties are depicted on Exhibit A, attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the owner desires for both properties to be located within the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16a of the Fire Protection District Act, 70 ILCS 705/16a, an owner of property on the border of two fire protection districts may disconnect from one and annex to another;

WHEREAS, the disconnection of the Subject Property from the Harvard Fire Protection District and annexation to the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District will not result in the isolation of any part of the Harvard Fire Protection District;

WHEREAS, the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District conducted a response-time study that shows the estimated response times from the Harvard Fire Protection District and the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District to the Subject Property, attached hereto as Exhibit B;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE HARVARD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT"), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of the Ordinance.

SECTION 2: The District consents to the disconnection of the Subject Property from the Harvard Fire Protection District and transferred to the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District. The Subject Property shall cease to be a part of the Harvard Fire Protection District and shall become an integral part of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District and shall be subject to all the enjoyments and responsibilities of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall

not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.



EXHIBIT A Depiction of Properties









EXHIBIT B Response-Time Study



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
